SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Abstracts should not be more than 300 words and must follow the IMRaD format.** The abstract shall include the following:
 - a. **Header:** Author's name, affiliation, email address, and contact number.
 - b. **Introduction:** An introduction of the problem area, its importance and the author's perspective on the problem. Conclude with an explicit statement of the research hypothesis, or questions to be explored in the study.
 - c. **Method:** An explanation of the study design and method/s used
 - d. **Results and Discussion:** A concise summary of the major findings of the experiment or study. Author should provide sufficient data to permit evaluation by the Review Committee.
 - e. **Conclusion:** Summary of the overall findings and the relevance of the study.
2. **All abstracts should be submitted in MS Word File to research@lcc.edu.ph or to LCCBResearch@gmail.com .**
3. **Notice of Acceptance will be sent via email to the submitting authors two (2) weeks after submission.**
4. **Deadline of Abstract Submission is on November 30, 2019.**
